## SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR WOOD TURNING:

- **Incomplete or illegible entry forms will be returned.**
- **No late entries will be accepted. No title or price changes after entry closing date.**
- **WOOD TURNING**—Wood Turning must be the predominant feature of the exhibit. No exhibit will receive more than one award, with the exception of the Popular Choice Award.
- **ELIGIBILITY**—Entries must not have won a prize in any previous Wood Turning Competition. All work must be original, and executed since June 2008.
- **ENTRY FEE**—An entry fee of \$10 for each Competition Entry will be included with the entry form.
- **PRICE**—All works must be for sale. Price must include 20% commission.
- **LIMIT**—1 piece per category.
- **LABELLING**—Your name, address, phone number, price, title of artwork, and timber type should be attached securely to the bottom of the entry.
- **DAMAGE/LOSS**—Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. While all due care will be taken, the Arts Festival Committee is not responsible for any damage or loss which may occur during the Festival.
- **FREIGHTED ARTWORK**—If your artwork is delivered or returned by freight, it must be suitably crated or boxed in rigid reusable packaging. The return address of the artist must be a street address and must be clearly marked. Return freight charge is \$25 per package and must be included with the entry form. **Do not send courier tickets.** During the week prior to the festival, couriered artwork can be sent to: Franklin Arts Festival, c/o Picturebook Design, 12 Wesley Street, Pukekohe 2120.
- **UNCOLLECTED ARTWORK**—**All entries must be collected on Sunday 13 September (between 3 and 5pm), unless prior arrangements have been made. Otherwise, a \$20 storage fee will be charged. After 1 October, uncollected artwork will be given to charity.**
- **JUDGING**—The decision of the judges is final. No discussion will be entered into.
- **CONFIDENTIALITY**—By entering this competition, the artist consents that his/her contact information can be shared with interested parties. However, contact details of those who purchase artwork at the Festival will remain confidential.
- **PUBLICITY**—By entering this competition, the artist agrees that the Franklin Arts Festival Society may use the entry for promotional or media purposes.
